Attention Homeowners:

The water samples collected yesterday (6/9) came back clean for total coliform and E. coli. The samples collected today have been submitted to the lab. The boil order remains in effect until 2 consecutive days of samples are clean. An update will be provided tomorrow (6/11) on the sample results and the boil order status.

Macy's is monitoring the levels in the tank at the potable water truck and will resupply when needed. The water truck will remain on-site at the Rafter J office for the duration of the boil order. *If you or anyone you know is experiencing difficulty obtaining water from the truck or boiling water at home, please let the Rafter J Office (307-733-5262, office@rafterj.org) know so we can provide assistance.*

Please follow the boil order notice protocols and refer to the additional best practices sheet that accompanied the boil order notice distributed yesterday.
